

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of El Paso County that the County Attorney Innovative Civil Enforcement and Community Protection be operated for the 2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds necessary for the said project as required by the Public Safety Office Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of El Paso designated the County Judge, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Commissioners Court agree that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor.
