Background: The 24- hour contact Domestic Violence Initiative is a model that seeks to respond to domestic/intimate partner violence crimes in ways that hold offenders accountable and restores victims' faith in accountability. The model provides increased attention to these crimes within the criminal justice system and the community at large and displays the benefits of increased community-wide collaboration to address family violence.
