Background:	<p>As part of Commissioners Court's vision to increase mobility opportunities for justice-involved individuals, the El Paso Promise Program is focused on providing job skills, workforce training, and educational opportunities to transition age youth (17-28 years of age) who are justice-involved. This comprehensive program will assist in the identification and placement of participants in interest-related, appropriate training and educational opportunities.</p> <p>As part of the second phase of establishing the El Paso Promise Program, community partners have been identified who can provide educational and workforce training opportunities to justice-involved participants.</p> <p>Workforce Solutions Borderplex (WSB) will provide individualized career navigation, job placement assistance, and access to industry-recognized training and certification programs for El Paso Promise participants. WSB will allocate up to \$6,000 in training support for up to five eligible participants, distributing funds quarterly at \$300 per participant. Additionally, WSB may offer wraparound services such as school supplies, transportation assistance, and other support to</p>

help remove barriers to success.
