


McCall Neighborhood Center

The McCall Neighbor Center in partnership with the Eastside-Central Coalition is executing its 2nd annual Black History Historical Bus Tour. The bus tour will be focusing on outstanding contributions of Black El Pasoans which led to the economic growth of El Paso. The tour will show El Paso's African American community moves eastward from downtown and the Downtown/Segundo Barrio, towards the city's present-day Five Points neighborhood, in that time called the Eastside neighborhood. The tour will identify El Paso "Black Wallstreet" businesses which were thriving during the 1940's, 50's, and 60's. Businesses ranged from barbershops to record stores, from funeral homes to pharmacies, doctor offices and music clubs the Black migration was symbol of the subsequent social and artistic explosion in a period considered a golden age in African American culture, manifesting in literature, music, stage performance and art.
