No County match is required. Further, approve and authorize the County Judge to sign the accompanying required Resolution. (Contract No. 2025-0113)
<b>Background:</b>	The work of this project fills identified gaps in the fight against human trafficking by: (1) identifying physical places ("properties") where human trafficking occurs or that have ties to human trafficking, and the business and property owners/landlords of those places (collectively "owners" unless identified otherwise); (2) identifying the activities or omissions of owners that contribute to the ability of traffickers to use the property for trafficking, and provide property specific solutions.
